## DSD Dance Center Guidelines For Jazz & Lyrical Company Teams

Below is a series of key technical steps for each age category. In order to place in that age category for jazz and lyrical, the steps must be executed with proper ballet technique. Dancers will be placed based on execution of technique as well as teacher discretion (not previous year placement or current age). Any dancer who does not place in jazz or lyrical but wishes to in the future is encouraged to take extra classes, privates, conventions, or recreational Jazz/lyrical to ensure technique growth and improve chances for next year.

## **Grades 1-4**

Turn out from the hips
Straight leg kicks
Right split with left and middle almost or already there
Proper preparation for a single pirouette
Single pirouette with proper ballet technique
Right/left leg leap with chasse preparation
Chaine turns with spot
Balance in releve

## Grades 5-8 Same as ages 7 & 8 plus....

Clean double pirouette
Soutenu turns
Controlled penche
Balance in releve passé
Center leap
Pique turns
Extensions (heel stretch, needle)
Battements

Illusion

## **Grades 9+** Same as ages 7-10 plus...

Clean triple pirouette
180 degree extensions (needles, heel stretches)
Double pique turns
Promenade arabesque
Grande a la seconde turns
Calypso

On the day of auditions, your child will be asked to perform each technique according to his/her grade. Placement will be based upon execution.
